

Community Trust Fund Annual Report 2010/2011



The Community Trust Fund is now in its fourteenth year. The Trust Benefits an area of approximately 10 miles radius from the Airport. Six Trustees are drawn from the Manchester Airport Consultative Committee to represent the council areas within the boundary. The seventh Trustee represents Manchester Airport plc.

In 2010/11, 94 grants have been awarded, amounting to £141,933 invested in community environmental or social projects.

Catholic Childrens Society (St Aidans Centre) received £2,500 towards acoustic panels for main hall.



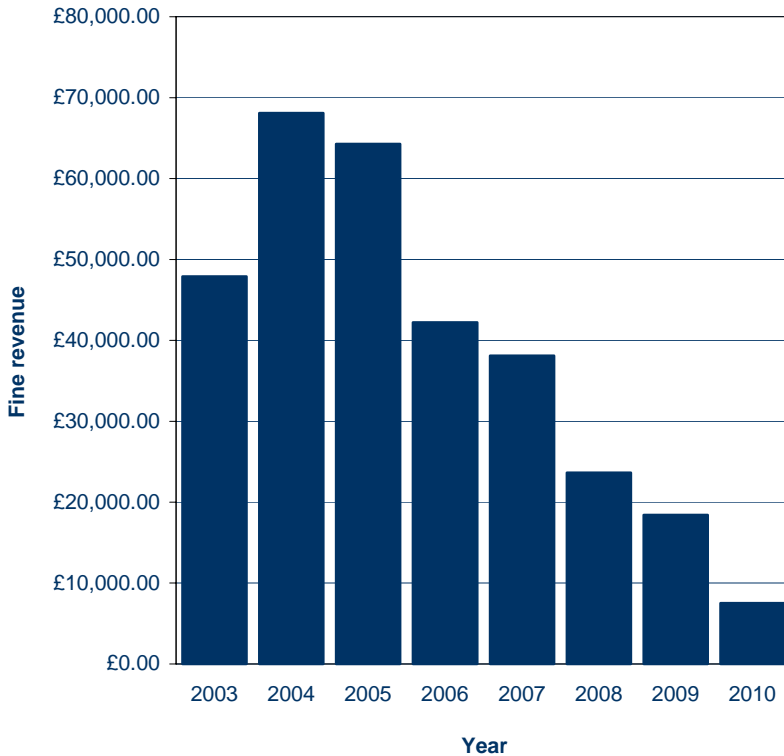

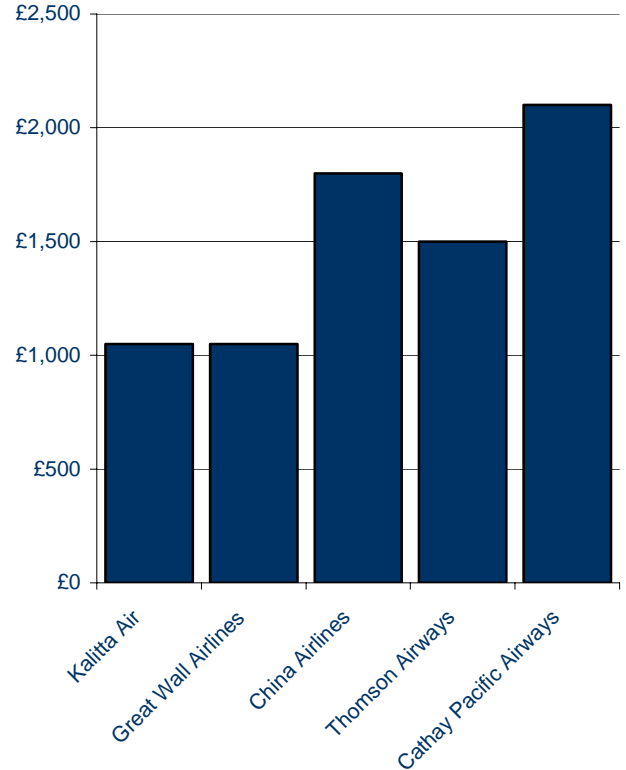
Where the monies are derived from:

The Community Trust Fund income is drawn from an annual £100,000 donation by Manchester Airport PLC and the remaining monies are derived from noise fines, which are imposed on airlines whose departing aircraft breach strict noise levels.

In addition to the Manchester Airport £100,000 contribution fund, there were noise fines totalling £7,500. Funds from previous years made up the remainder of the £141,933 invested during the year.

Modern aircraft are significantly quieter than their predecessors and our income from noise fines has fallen over the years. Our fining limits are consequently regularly reviewed against the mix of aircraft operating from the Airport as a part of our strategy to encourage quietest operations. In April 2010, the daytime fining level was reduced from 105 to 103 PNdB. Please see the table to the right to see how our limits compare against those of our peers.

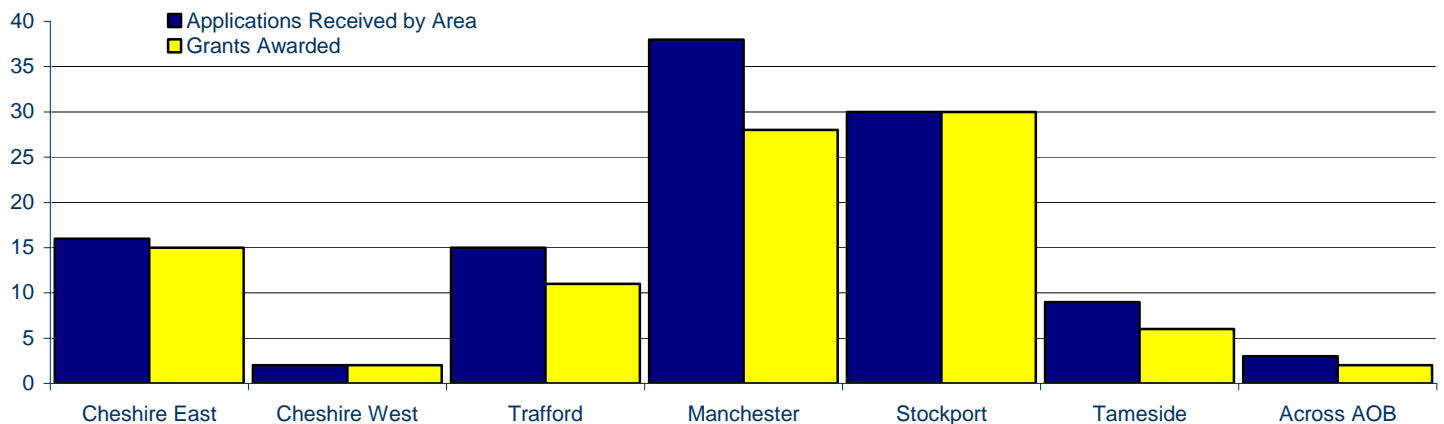

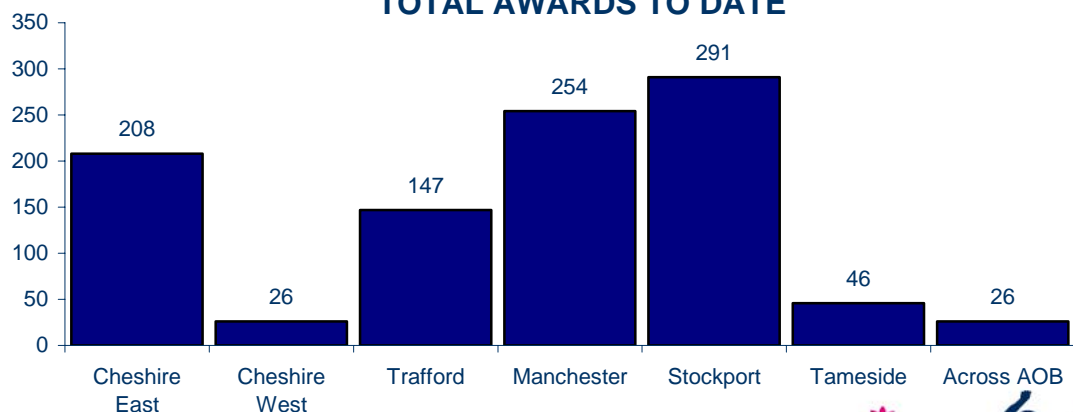
